

The German composer Karl Johann Weber is rehearsing a new opera at an isolated villa in the hills of the Venetian mainland. Would Tito accept the lead role? Happily, artist Gussie Rumbolt, Tito s friend and brother-in-law, has also been summoned to paint scenes of the estate s grape harvest. The countryside is awash with the golden hues of autumn, but the bucolic mood turns menacing when a notorious figure from Tito s past turns up at the villa. Then at the stroke of twelve, a soprano stumbles over a stranger who has been beaten to death with the clock pendulum. With the local constable away on a boar hunt, the midnight murderer has struck with impunity, raising terror to a fevered crescendo. So Tito pursues his own quest for answers-straight into the painful secrets of his heart and beyond.
